## DISABILITY INSURANCE BLUE VISION (GLOBAL PLAN)

## Proof of income is always required for:

- ➤ An insurance amount of \$3,500 or more
- ➤ The option to submit proof of income with the application, unless otherwise stipulated below

Must be working from home for at least 1 year		
Proof of income for the last 2 years

<b>3</b> If they have been working from home for less than a year in a different field from the previous occupation:		
Must be working from home for at least 6 months		
Maximum benefit of \$1,300

<ul> <li>Agreements or contracts established for the upcoming year</li> </ul>		
• Proof of income for the year		
2 If they have been working for less than 2 years in a different field from the previous occupation:		
<ul> <li>Must be working from home for at least 1 year</li> </ul>		
• Proof of income for the last 2 years		
<ul> <li>Cannot choose the option to submit proof of income with the application.</li> <li>Proof of income will be required when submitting a claim.</li> </ul>		
<b>3</b> If they have been working from home for less than 1 year in a different field from the previous occupation:		
Must be working from home for at least 6 months		
• Maximum benefit of \$1,300

No proof of income	90 days	2 or 5 years

Self-employed persons working 20 to 100% of the time <u>from home for more than 2 years</u> and having an income between \$17,000 and \$25,000 after expenses and before taxes	90 days	2 or 5 years
Proof of income for the last 2 years		
Self-employed persons working 20 to 100% of the time <u>from home for less than 2 years</u> and having an income between \$17,000 and \$25,000 after expenses and before taxes	90 days	2 or 5 years
<ul> <li>Employment in the same field or in a related field for 2 years</li> <li>Proof of income for the last 2 years</li> </ul>		
Self-employed persons working 20% or less of the time from home	Chosen by insured	Chosen by insured
All workers from categories 2A, A and B working from home and who do not meet the criteria mentioned above	120 days	2 years

Special consideration (occupational category A)	Waiting period	Benefit period
Educators working 100% of the time from home without certification (without completed studies in Early Childhood Education or accreditation recognized by a Home Childcare Coordinating Office) and having a minimun income of \$12,000 after expenses and before taxes	120 days	2 years
